



PLAYING TENNIS & SQUASH AT THORNDON IN ALERT LEVEL 2

Along with Tennis courts in Alert level 3, Squash courts will be available for use from 14 May 2020 as per the latest government announcement.

Courts Open

- Squash – Courts One, Two, Three & Four
- Tennis – Courts Three, Four & Five

To Book a Court

1. Email Club Manager, Brad Watts via info@thorndonclub.co.nz to book a court. **No online bookings will be accepted.**
2. All participants that enter the club are required to complete the Contact tracing form available via QR code on the poster as you enter the club or before visiting the club using the link – <https://simpletrace.nz/checkin/THO14>

Note: Make bookings 6 hours in advance to ensure you secure a suitable time. No booking confirmations are required once you have emailed to book a court. Court lights will turn on automatically.

Rules to be Followed

- Clubhouse, bathrooms, kitchen, bar & sauna are closed (subject to weekly review)
- Access to squash courts is via upstairs balcony door (due to clubhouse closure)
- Games must take place at your designated time and you must leave afterwards
- Where possible limit the number of players you play each week. No group should be larger than 10 people at any time
- Coaching may recommence however the groups must be no larger than a group of 10 and have all contact tracing information available on request
- You must adhere to all the advised health messages – **Do not visit the club if you are unwell**
 - Keep a physical distance of 1 metre
 - Make use of hand sanitiser which is available at the front gate in the squash area & in a basket on tennis court 3. This should be completed on entry and exit.
 - Only players can go to the courts (no spectators)
 - You must supply your own equipment (racquets and balls) and not share them with anyone outside your bubble
 - Minimise contact with common surfaces such as nets, fences, and walls

Squash Specific

- Do not wipe your hands on squash court walls
- Make use of spray bottles on each squash court for door handles, chairs & balustrades

What happens if we do not follow the rules?

Make sure you enjoy your game, but we need to ensure that you follow the required health guidelines set out. If these rules are not followed the Club will have to close for an extended period.

Who can play?

The Club is now available for all members to play and book courts. This includes Corporate members however please ensure to follow the correct procedures listed above **especially contact tracing**

For non-members \$5 visitor fees will recommence with bookings. This can be done via contactless payment. Contact Brad to discuss invoicing.

What are we doing to keep you safe?

- Providing sanitizer for entry and exit
- Disinfectant spray bottles will be available for common areas including outside each squash court
- Tennis court nets are cleaned weekly with disinfectant
- Squash courts are cleaned weekly with disinfectant
